The Day of the Dead (Día de los Muertos in Spanish) is a feast celebrated mainly in Latin America and by Latinos (and others) living in the United States and in Canada. Traditions include building private altars honouring the deceased, using sugar skulls, marigolds, and the favourite food and beverages of the departed, and visiting graves with these as gifts.
